There is always more time to stay if needed past 5:00PM. **Students are asked to stay in the homework room for 30 minutes due to our staff/child ratios.** If the child completes their homework before 30 minutes there are plenty of flash cards, puzzles, books and games to keep them occupied for the remainder of the 30 minutes.
