Pavilion Project Update

The pavilion is up and running and has hosted a number of gatherings since our last update, including: Palm Sunday children's celebration, Easter Sunrise service, Nursery School graduation, Reformation Lunch Bunch, and our synod's Inclusive Communities picnic.

Directly behind the pavilion, the rain garden is almost complete! We are just waiting on the as-built engineering prints. This space enables us to properly manage our storm water that needs to be offset by the new impervious ground from the pavilion. Many thanks to Vince Walsh, Kristen Forster, and Jamie Anderson for their work on this project!

We have had a number of landscaping updates around our pavilion, including new plantings, re-mulching our woodchip walking path, and installing a flagpole area that will honor Reformation's veterans and their families.

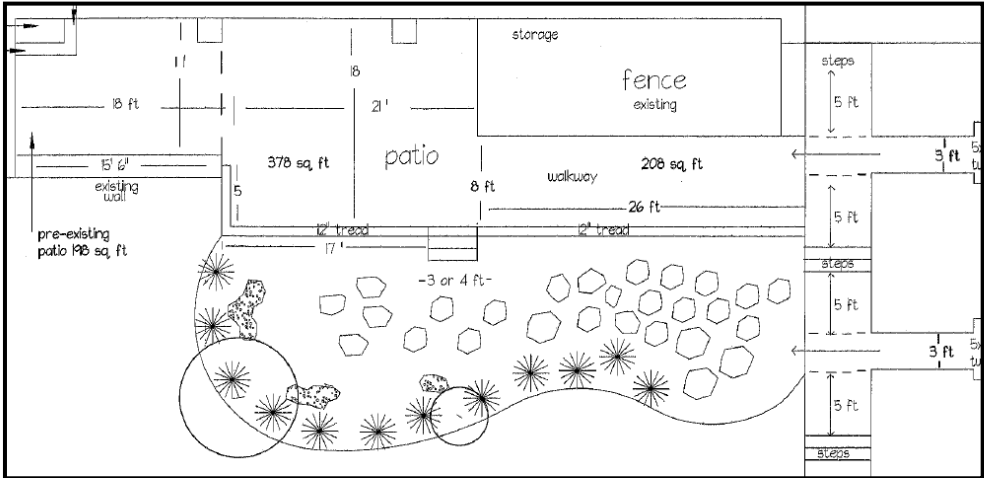
The last remaining component of the pavilion includes electrical work to add lighting to the space in the near future.

Reflection Garden Update

The plans for the reflection garden are currently at the engineer. Once those sealed prints are returned, we will be able to submit them to the township and begin to work more fully on this project!

The Reflection Garden will be constructed along the outer wall of the Sanctuary and will be two levels—one hardscaped patio, and one garden area where cremated ashes may be interred. Both levels of the garden will be made fully accessible through the reconstruction of our cement walkways and ramps. Blueprints are included here for you to envision this space!
