Reformation's Community Action Ministry Team invites you to help us Fill the Freezer for Caring for Friends!

On Tuesday, July 7, and Thursday, July 23, you will be able to pick up Caring for Friends meal and soup kits and drop off completed soup and meal kits at a contactless "drive-through" behind Reformation. You will need to enter from the west parking lot, proceed around the back of the building to the pick-up/drop-off site outside of Creighton Hall, then depart through the east parking lot.

- Thursday, July 23, 10:00 am—12:00 noon

Completed meals and soups must be in Caring for Friends containers with completed labels. All of the necessary supplies will be in the kits to pick-up.

Recipes of suggested meals will be provided for you to use by Reformation member and Registered Dietitian, Danielle Burke.

In addition to the basic meal packets or soup cups, please consider making a card, picture, or note letting the recipient know they are thought of by you. (Do not include any religious or political statement as they might differ from those of the recipient.) The card can be signed with your first name and the church name.
