Worship on the Way Volunteer Information

All volunteers will park in the east lot (facing Providence Road) and check-in with the pastors and deacon by the main entrance of the church building when they arrive on the property.

Set-up Volunteers will:

- Arrive at Reformation by 8:30 am
- Wear a mask and maintain social distancing at all times while on Reformation's property
- Help set cones and other directional signage for Worship on the Way from 8:30 – 9:30 am

Entrance Volunteers will:

- Arrive at Reformation by 9:00 am
- Wear a mask and maintain social distancing at all times while on Reformation's property
- Wear a safety vest
- Flag entering vehicles and ensure they are safely lining up to go through the property in the correct path from 9:30 – 11:00 am

Worship Volunteers will:

- Arrive at Reformation by 9:30 am
- Wear a mask and maintain social distancing at all times while on Reformation's property
- Lead a Worship on the Way station from 10:00-11:00 am
- Lead station specific responsibilities
 - Check in
 - Greet each vehicle
 - Ask for names of those in vehicles
 - If they are on the pre-registration list check off their attendance
 - If not record their names, number in the vehicle, and a best contact phone number
 - Ask them to confirm health check
 - Prayer
 - Greet each vehicle
 - Pray the Prayer of the Day with them
 - Hand them the Scripture to Go sheet and encourage them to use the scripture resource when they arrive at home

- Offering
 - Greet each vehicle
 - Receive any offering items (food donations, offering envelopes, etc) and place them in the appropriate places
- Communion
 - Greet each vehicle
 - A pastor will celebrate communion with each vehicle and distribute pre-packaged communion sets
- Blessing/Sending
 - Greet each vehicle
 - Offer the blessing
 - Hand out any sending gifts
 - Share the dismissal and wish them well as they leave the property
- Help clean up cones and other directional signage from Worship
