Stations in the Street Prayer Path. The wood chipped path around the Reformation property will once again host Stations in the Street – an art exhibit of the stations of the cross by Scott Erikson. You are welcome to visit the path anytime during Lent – **February 14** to **March 31**. Booklets with information about the art and reflections from the artist are at the entrance of the path (in the corner of the East Parking Lot farthest from the gazebo).

Life Abundant - Lent Art Installation. Butterflies are an ancient symbol of new life. This year's art display in the sanctuary will feature a butterfly on our wooden cross and will have an opportunity for everyone to participate in making the butterfly come to life on Easter Sunday!
